Year 7 Book Club Visit to the British Library, London – Monday 1 April

We are planning an exciting event for our Year 7 Book Club students to visit the British Library, on Monday 1 April.

Students will be participating in a workshop entitled Questioning Texts, which will involve reviewing historical and contemporary extracts from the Library's own collection to develop an understanding of context and chronology within English Literature.

In the afternoon we will be taking a self-guided tour of the Treasures Gallery which features artefacts including the beautifully illustrated Lindisfarne Gospels, Beowulf and Bede's Ecclesiastical History, Leonardo da Vinci's notebooks, Alice's Adventures in Wonderland original manuscript and Jane Austen's writing desk.

We will be travelling to London by coach, departing from school at 7.45am and returning at approximately 3.20pm. Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with them on the day. Please provide details of any specific dietary requirements your child has. Students should bring no more than £10 to spend, should they wish to make a purchase at the gift shop.
