Safeguarding

An issue that parents and children are raising in many schools is that children are being added to WhatsApp groups that they do not wish to be in. WhatsApp have recently added a feature that enables users to stop others adding them to groups without their consent. To enable it: Open WhatsApp on your phone, and go to Settings > Accounts > Privacy. Tap on Groups, and select the option that suits you best:

- Nobody (this stops anyone from adding you to a group without an invitation)
- My contacts (only your contacts can add you to a group without an invitation)
- Anyone (Anyone can add you to a group without an invitation)
 The advice for anyone who values privacy is to select the 'Nobody' option.


