

RAVENS LANE CANAL BRIDGE ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS



Essential maintenance works are due to commence on Ravens Lane Canal Bridge. These works are programmed to start on Monday 3rd February 2020 and have a planned duration of 6 weeks.

During this period, there will be several phases of works requiring different traffic management arrangements. These will be in place to ensure the safety of both works operatives and members of the public during the works (see schedule below for details).

While works are being conducted under the bridge, the canal and towpath will be closed. Advance warning signs along the canal will notify users of the works ahead and a suitable diversion route will be provided for pedestrians.

While works are being conducted on top of the bridge, a road closure will be required. A clearly signed diversion shall be provided for motorists and pedestrian access shall be maintained at all times.

What are we doing?

The works to be carried out include:

- Parapet repairs,
- Re-painting of the bridge,
- Re-waterproofing of the bridge deck,
- Re-surfacing of carriageway and footway,
- Installation of the "Port of Berkhamsted" signs and canal heritage artwork over the canal.

We are also delighted to advise that we are planning to enhance the image of the bridge substantially by consulting with the Chairman of "Berkhamsted Citizens". "Berkhamsted Citizens" have joined us in designing a revitalized entrance to the port of Berkhamsted which we believe underpins the industrial history of your amazing town & its canal heritage.

How will this affect you?

During the programmed road closures, traffic using Ravens Lane will be diverted, which may impact your journey time. During the programmed canal closure, users will not be able to pass under the bridge.

The dates for restrictions are as follows:

Restriction	Working Times	Start Date	End Date
Canal and Towpath - Closure	24 hours	03-Feb-20	13-Mar-20
Gravel Path - Road Closure	24 hours	17-Feb-20	13-Mar-20

What are we asking you to do?

We appreciate your patience during this essential works and will endeavour to keep disruption to an absolute minimum as we complete these works as quickly as possible.

All traffic restrictions are in place for the safety of both the travelling public and the workforce.

We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause and appreciate your co-operation whilst these works are in progress.

Additional Information

These works are weather dependent and from time to time unforeseen circumstances arise, any changes to the proposed start date, duration or working hours will be notified on the information boards located either side of the bridge. This information will also be made available on our website <u>www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/roadworks</u> which can be accessed by scanning the QR code on this letter.

Neither Hertfordshire County Council, nor their contractors will approach you offering to carry out works to your property. Any cold calling of this nature by people claiming to represent Hertfordshire should be viewed with suspicion and be reported to us.
