

## MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Medical insurance for journeys abroad does not include cover in the event of illness arising from any pre-existing medical condition.

The health requirements for the country of entry should be ascertained, as should the recommendations for the prevention of ill health in that country (refer to leaflet 'Protect Your Health Abroad' available from travel agents).

It is most important that we should know of any pre-existing medical condition (for example, asthma, diabetes, heart trouble), which may require treatment.

If, within two days prior to departure on the journey, your child becomes ill you should have him/her seen by your own doctor.
