Covid Guidance: Update

It is important that parents review the accompanying flowchart which details steps to take if your child is symptomatic with any of the three core symptoms of Covid19 described, or if a member of the household has any of these symptoms. **Please do not send your child into school if any member of the household has these symptoms** and follow the guidance, which is in line with our risk assessment and NHS guidelines.

In addition, in the event of being contacted by the official test and trace team and told to self-isolate, you must follow that guidance and inform the school via <u>attendance@ashlyns.herts.sch.uk</u> as quickly as possible.

A terrific first week

We are so pleased to have welcomed our staff and students back into school, and very proud of how swiftly students have adapted to all the additional measures including the one-way system, face masks in corridors and regular handwashing. Please discuss with your child, ensure they have a face covering and spare with them, and reinforce the need to continue with these important processes. Please also remind your child to bring their Wisepay card with them each day and keep it in a safe place as it is linked to their account.

Uniform from Monday

From Monday we will be checking uniform closely: please check with your child that they have the correct understanding of our expectations and our rules on:

 - Ashlyns PE top; black shorts covered with plain black tracksuit bottoms and/or plain black sports leggings thin, flimsy or otherwise inappropriate leggings will not be permitted
 - Over the top, students may wear an Ashlyns PE hoodie (this is the Ashlyns PE hoodie, not a 'Class-of' hoodie or any other form of hoodie; not a jumper) OR blazer



Covid-19 Protocols for Parents and Students

- SYMPTOMS
- 1. A high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- 2. A new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- 3. A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
