Uniform

As Autumn takes hold and we start to welcome winter please can we encourage parents to ensure their children as prepared for school. Our <u>COVID-19 risk assessment</u> means that corridors and classrooms have to be well ventilated, quite often with doors and windows remaining open throughout the day.
