### Safeguarding Part II

When students leave school, they are subject to the new national restrictions in place which can be found <u>here</u>. Police have asked us to remind students that they should therefore not congregate in town, but should go swiftly home, maintaining social distancing - and that obstruction of police in enforcing these rules will be challenged robustly.

### DFE Guidance Update: Clinically Extremely Vulnerable students

- Students who have been identified by their doctor as still considered clinically extremely vulnerable (CEV), are advised not to come into school. The <u>government guidance</u> on shielding and CEV people has been updated to reflect this position. School provide remote learning for any students in this category.
- Students who live with people who are CEV, but are not CEV themselves, are still expected to come into school.




