Updated Guidance on Self-Isolation

You may have seen news today that the Government has updated their guidance on the self-isolation period for close contacts which will be reduced from 14 days to 10 days. This is to take effect from Monday 14 December and is applicable to anyone who is currently self-isolating. We will be contacting any existing isolating students who now have a shortened isolation period, to ensure they know their revised date to return to school.

End of Term Arrangements

You may be aware that the DfE has suggested that if schools were concerned about their capacity to carry out Track and Trace in the first week of the school holidays, they might wish to close to students a day earlier than planned. However, to do so, we would have to replace the final day with an INSET day and add a full teaching day somewhere else in the calendar. This would, obviously, be very difficult - particularly at this late stage - and as such, **we will be sticking with our published term dates i.e. the final day will remain as Friday 18th December, finishing at 12.30pm**. Should we receive any further updates from the DfE, we will of course let you know as soon as possible.

While we are unable to serve a traditional Christmas lunch for the students next week, we will be serving Christmas themed fare, catering for all dietary requirements, across the whole week, with all the trimmings!

Christmas break Covid arrangements

If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) at any point during the Christmas break, please notify us as soon as possible so we can complete the relevant tracking and tracing process with public health, if required, and notify any other children or staff who have been close contacts and who need to self-isolate. During the holidays you should contact **covid@ashlyns.herts.sch.uk – this will only be monitored until Christmas Eve as after this point your child(ren) shouldn't be a close contact of anyone at the school.** Please don't call the normal absence line as this won't be covered during Christmas term.

Remember as soon as your child or any member of your household develops symptoms, they must start self-isolating immediately and book a test regardless of it being Christmas.

Main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- A loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If you're not sure whether symptoms suggest that they have COVID-19 or an everyday cough or cold, you can consult this online NHS symptom checker: <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/>

Please do not send children back to school if any of the following apply:

- They have symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19)
- They, any members of your household, or any close contacts (including extended family or friends they have seen and bubbles at holiday activities and sports clubs) have tested positive for COVID-19
- They haven't completed the full 10 day isolation period requested


