# **Covid Testing and Reporting**

Sadly, case rates continue to rise in the UK, and Hertfordshire is no different. Please do not send children in if:

- They have any symptoms of Covid-19 (a new, continuous cough, change or loss of taste or smell, a high temperature) – in this instance you must book a PCR test
- They have been identified as a close contact and/or asked to self-isolate
- If they are generally unwell, including colds, headaches and runny noses –
  it's better to be safe than sorry

It is important that students and staff continue to take twice-weekly Lateral Flow Tests to help reduce the spread of the virus. Please continue to report positive, negative and void LFT results to both <a href="NHS Test & Trace">NHS Test & Trace</a> and the school via the <a href="Online form">online form</a>. If the result of the test is unclear (void) you should do another test.

We encourage all parents and carers to take regular tests too: you can order online, collect from a pharmacy or visit a mobile testing site, view your options at: <a href="www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/rapidtest">www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/rapidtest</a>. If you test positive using a rapid test you must book a confirmatory PCR test at: <a href="www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test">www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</a>. Your whole household must begin self-isolating immediately.

## Lockers

If your child has a locker please ask them to empty it before the end of term as no one will be allocated the same locker next term. Any items left in the lockers will be bagged up, labelled with the locker number and put in the lost property cupboard.


## **Bedrock**
