

Careers STEM

This week HS2 visited Ashlyns to deliver a whole day career event focusing on engineering and career paths in STEM. Students in Year 8 and 9 worked in teams to design and draw the train station of the future, plus design and construct a weight-bearing tunnel out of only 40 straws employing engineering principles. Our speaker commented: 'I had a fantastic day at Ashlyns. The students engaged extraordinarily well with the practical activities and I was very impressed with the questions they asked and the quality of their finished products.'

Careers Fair

This week a group of our Year 11 students visited the Generation Dacorum Careers Fair at Shendish Manor and had the opportunity to meet over 30 employers from growing employment sectors in Hertfordshire. Our students conducted themselves impeccably and were a credit to the school. One student commented: 'I found it really helpful as it helped broaden my understanding of options for my future career path.'

CSI - Enter the World of Forensic Science Careers Event

On Thursday 13 October we are hosting a Forensic Science careers event for Year 8 students. Working in small groups, teams are presented with a 'crime scene' to investigate. Using devices, students must forensically analyse the evidence and collaborate as a team to find the perpetrator of the crime. This 2-hour event will take place during the school day.
