Year 13 Economics Revision Workshop - Tuesday 25 April

I have arranged for the Year 13 Economics students to attend an intensive one-day revision workshop at Westfield White City, London, on Tuesday 25 April.

Students will attend the Grade Booster workshop, designed to provide essential revision support as they complete their preparation for the exams in the summer. The workshop will refine and sharpen key exam technique, build confidence in essential assessment skills, boost knowledge of key economics data and context and provide a clear focus and structure for students on how to make the most effective use of the remaining revision time. Students will also receive a workshop booklet.

The cost of this trip is £45.00 per student (excluding travel, see below). Payment should be made by ParentPay by Friday 31 March at the latest. For students in receipt of Bursary, please complete this form by Friday 31 March: [Year 13 Economics Revision Workshop. Bursary Funding](#).

We will be travelling to and from the venue by train. Students should arrive at Berkhamsted train station at 8.30am with the money to purchase a train ticket (approximately £26, or £18 if students have a railcard). We plan to return at around 4.30pm.

Although I intend for us to travel back to Berkhamsted together, if students decide they would like to make their own way back from London at the end of day, written permission must first be given by parents/carers; please complete ParentPay accordingly.

Please note that the school's policy is that trips and other activities outside the normal teaching programme should be self-funding. Contributions are voluntary, but if these are insufficient the trip may have to be cancelled.
