# **Dr Van Der Spoel Study Sessions**

Dr. Van Der Spoel visited Ashlyns this week to work with Years 7, 8 and 9 on the psychology of studying. This intervention is part of a larger programme the school puts in place to help your child learn how to study effectively.

The session focused on two key ideas, 'You are teacher number 1' and 'You can increase your ability to focus', looking at how the brain works, memory techniques and tips on engaging in lessons.


