Home Study Arrangements for Year 13

From Monday 2 October, Year 13 students must continue to register with their Form Tutor every morning, but will be permitted to leave school after Period 2 if they do not have a lesson or a Directed Study hour during Periods 3, 4 and 5. Alternatively, they will be permitted to leave school after Period 3 or Period 4 if they do not have a lesson during Periods 4/5. This is to enable students to go home to study, however, students are very welcome to stay in school to use the LRC or Sixth Form study facilities.

Please note that students must continue to register every morning and be in school for every timetabled lesson, form period, PE session, assembly and Enrichment session, and for all Directed Study hours. Students must also sign out using one of the biometric machines and inform their Form Tutor of their home study arrangements. Home study will be granted on an individual basis; please fill out the online form via the link below to indicate which home study sessions you have agreed with your child. **All students must also arrange an appointment to discuss their preferred options for home study with Mrs Loczy in the Sixth Form Office before their home study arrangements begin.**
