GCSE PE Video Evidence

As we approach the end of the GCSE PE course our focus now turns to ensuring that our students are ready for the Component 3- Practical assessment.

For any activity that cannot be shown live within school on the moderation day we need to have recorded evidence to justify the marks awarded. Some of you may also wish to record footage from your sport or activity from outside of school if it allows them to access more marks from the assessment criteria, e.g. playing for a higher level team in netball/ football.

I have attached a presentation from the exam board to help and the FAQ guide, which is from 2018, but does provide some further guidance from Pearson.

Please ensure that any video footage shows the necessary skills in isolation and also the application of skills in a competitive environment otherwise we cannot award any marks for those sections. It is also prudent to note that the evidence must justify the marks awarded and we can only assess what we see on the footage.

The nature of the recorded footage means that the files will be large in size and so the most efficient way to share these files with your teacher is to create a Google Drive folder, add the evidence to the folder, and then share this folder with your teacher, as they will be too large to share via email. We can also accept data sticks or other methods of transfer so please do let us know if there are any issues.

The deadline for submission of the video evidence is **Monday 26 February**.
