Year 7 Trip to the Science Museum – Tuesday 5 March 2024

I am delighted to inform you that, as part of our accelerated Key Stage 3 Science course, we have been able to secure a day of activities at the Science Museum in London on **Tuesday 5 March 2024**.

Year 7 students will be able to spend the whole day focusing on the Science component of their Key Stage 3 studies, and we propose to use this unique day to take **every student** in the year group to the Museum.

The trip is a valuable opportunity for students to see many dynamic, up-to-date, interactive exhibitions which complement and enhance the understanding of the Science National Curriculum.

One of the key galleries we will be visiting is 'Turn it up: The power of music', an interactive exhibition looking at how music shapes our lives and the science involved, including the involvement of robots and machines to make music. Students will be encouraged to take part and experiment in exhibits by playing and doing.

The cost of this trip, including entry to the 'Turn it up: The power of music' exhibition and return coach travel, is £20.00 per student. Payment may be made by ParentPay by **Thursday 1 February 2024** at the latest. Payments are non-refundable.

Please note that the school's policy is that trips and other activities outside the normal teaching programme should be self-funding. Contributions are voluntary but if contributions are insufficient the trip may have to be cancelled. In cases of genuine hardship, please contact Mrs Wilson in the Finance Office in confidence by Wednesday 17 January 2024.

Students will be registered in the **Chapel at 8.10am**. We plan to return around 4.30pm depending on traffic. Please arrange for your child to be collected from school at this later time if necessary.

Students are required to wear school uniform and will need to bring a packed lunch and a pencil case.

Please note that students will **not** have an opportunity to buy food, drinks or gifts in the shop at the museum.
