Nobody will be forced to share a bed





Packing

PLEASE ENSURE ALL ITEMS ARE NAMED

- Full pencil case
- Small rucksack and a large plastic bag to act as a groundsheet
- Pocket money for which you are responsible - £15 should be enough (in change works best)
