## Year 11 Parent-Teacher Consultation Evening – Wednesday 23 October Online Appointment Booking

We would therefore encourage parents to prioritise appointment requests, having reflected on the data that will be made available on Arbor nearer the time and focusing on subjects where you have questions about progress.
