## Year 13 Business and Economics Revision Workshop - Friday 28 March 2025

We are pleased to offer Year 13 Business and Economics students the opportunity to attend an intensive one-day revision workshop at Westfield White City, London, on Friday 28 March 2025.

Students will attend the Grade Booster workshop, specifically designed to provide essential revision support as they prepare for their summer exams. Students will also receive a workshop booklet.
