Year 11 Exams and Study Leave

As you will be aware, we are rapidly approaching the beginning of the summer examinations for Year 11; the exam season begins in earnest on Thursday 8 May, and the first core examination is on Monday 12 May. We appreciate your help and support at what is a stressful time of year for students as they enter the last days before these examinations. All students should now be following their own independent revision timetable each day, in conjunction with revision and home-learning set by their teachers. If students need help or support in this, please ask them to come to Session 6 in the LRC, running Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, 3.20pm to 4.20pm, where we can offer additional support. We are looking forward to seeing many of them next week at Easter revision sessions.

Registration and payment is still open for the Saturday Supercrams - you do not need to re-register if you have already registered, but if you have not, please do encourage your child to come. Those last few hours with their teachers close to the exams can be really beneficial; if you wish to register your child now, the schedule can be found [here](#). Students will receive study leave during the examinations, beginning on Thursday 8 May, and we will contact you in due course to confirm arrangements for their final day, which will be Wednesday 7 May. After this date, students will come into school only for any organised revision sessions and for their examinations; any time in school will be in full school uniform, continuing to follow all rules about uniform and appearance until after the final examination. On days when students have more than one examination, they will be in school in between.

Examinations finish on Wednesday 18 June; please see your child's individual examination timetable to check when individual final exams are as they will be different for each student. Please note that all students need to be available for exams contingency day, which is Wednesday 25 June. Sixth Form Induction, for those who have applied to the Sixth Form, takes place on Monday 30 June; details of this will follow in due course. Finally, the Year 11 Prom takes place on the evening of Thursday 3 July.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the support you have given us this year, and we look forward to celebrating the Year 11 students' time with us, both on their final day in their celebration assembly and at the Prom.
