Year 13 UCAS and Careers Day - Thursday 13 November

This term, our Extended Learning Day for Year 13 students has been designated for UCAS, Degree Apprenticeship, and Careers support, and will take place on Thursday 13 November. The students will begin the day with a presentation on the UCAS process and alternatives to university. They will then spend the rest of the day working with staff on their university applications and Personal Statements, or their apprenticeship or job applications. The school's deadline for UCAS is 10 December.

We will have a careers advisor working with students in groups and on an individual basis throughout the day. They will be available for advice on careers and apprenticeships, CV writing, and interview techniques. Students who wish to make an appointment to see the school's Careers Advisor, outside of our Careers and UCAS day, should speak to Mrs Turner in the Sixth Form Office. **All students will need to bring their own electronic devices; this must not be a mobile phone.**
