Dear Parent/Carer

Year 10 Activity Days – 15 and 16 July 2026

The last week of term, commencing 13 July 2026, includes two activity days, one of which is a visit to Thorpe Park.

Wednesday 15 July – It's a Knockout and Sports Activities

It's a Knockout is a half-day activity session. The activities include inflatable obstacles where students compete as teams to complete the games. The activities are designed to cater for all abilities and the It's a Knockout team ensures everyone is included. Safety protocols are in place for each obstacle.

In addition to this, students will also participate in a sports carousel and various activities. Students will need their **PE kit** and a **change of clothes** on the day. We will also have a local ice cream van visiting from which all students will receive an ice cream.

Thursday 16 July – Thorpe Park

The second activity day involves a trip to Thorpe Park, where students can choose from the many rides and activities while spending time with their friends as the term comes to a close.

We recommend students bring a **packed lunch**, however, there will be opportunities to purchase drinks, small snacks, and souvenirs. For those planning to go on wet rides, please bring a **change of clothes**.

We will travel by coach, leaving school promptly at **9.00am** (registration will take place at the usual time) and returning at approximately **5.30pm**. Students are not required to wear school uniform but should dress in **comfortable and appropriate clothing**.

Costs and Payment Information

The total cost for both activities is **£54.00**, which includes travel, insurance, Thorpe Park tickets, and the It's a Knockout activities. Payment should be made via ParentPay by **Thursday 30 April 2026** at the latest.

For students with a valid Merlin Pass, please contact Ms Domokos in the Finance Office for details of the reduced cost. Please note that it is the student's responsibility to bring and look after their pass on the day.

A full risk assessment has been undertaken for the above activities, and appropriate control measures are in place.

Additional Information

I understand that the cost of these activity days may create additional expenses for families, particularly for those with multiple children at Ashlyns. However, these activities have been selected because they provide students with:

- Increased confidence
- Opportunities to identify leadership potential
- Lasting memories before their final year at Ashlyns
- Strengthened friendships

Please note that the school's policy is that trips and other activities outside the normal teaching programme should be self-funding. Contributions are voluntary but if these are insufficient the trip/activities may have to be cancelled.
