Thursday 13 August: A Level results

Results will be available for collection from the Hall from **8.00am until 10.30am** and then available on students' Arbor accounts from 11.00am.

If you wish to utilise the school's facilities to enter the Clearing or Adjustment process through UCAS, you will need to have your UCAS username and password with you.
