Year 10 Activity Days reminder – 15 and 16 July 2026

The last week of term, commencing 13 July 2026, includes two Activity Days, one of which is a visit to Thorpe Park.

Wednesday 15 July – It's a Knockout and Sports Activities. It's a Knockout is a half-day activity session. The activities include inflatable obstacles where students compete as teams to complete the games. The activities are designed to cater for all abilities and the 'It's a Knockout' team ensures everyone is included. Excellent safety protocols are in place for each obstacle. In addition to this, students will also participate in a sports carousel and various activities. Students should arrive in school wearing PE kit that is appropriate for the summer weather. They should also bring a change of sportswear. A hat and sunscreen is also advisable. A full risk assessment has been undertaken for the above activities, and appropriate control measures are in place.

Thursday 16 July – Thorpe Park. The second activity day involves a trip to Thorpe park where students can choose from the many rides and activities while spending time with their friends as the term comes to a close. We recommend students bring a packed lunch; however, there will be opportunities to purchase drinks, small snacks, and souvenirs. For those planning to go on wet rides, please bring a change of clothes. We will travel by coach, leaving school promptly at 8.30am. We expect students to arrive at school for **8.00am** with registration taking place at **8.10am in the Chapel** and return at approximately **5.30pm**. Students are not required to wear school uniform but should dress in comfortable and appropriate clothing. It has been decided that students may use their phones on the Thorpe Park trip. However, please remind them they must not take photos of staff members or other students and upload them to social media or other websites.
